TRANSPORTATION

1. Support and take action on current transportation positions.
2. Support dedicated funding and a community based vision for a regional, multimodal public transportation system, including adequate funding for LYNX.
3. Provide public education on transportation/transit issues.
4. Support development of a transit system based on a plan designed by the grassroots community.

NATURAL RESOURCES

1. Support and take action on current LWVF positions with a focus on WATER.
2. Monitor current Orange County Land Acquisition program and support dedicated funding for acquisition of endangered lands.

EDUCATION

1. Support and take action on current positions.
2. Monitor planned cuts and the impact they will have on school services.

LOCAL GOVERNMENT

1. Support and take action on current positions.
2. Continue to monitor and support ethics reform in County Government.
3. Continue to urge continued review of consolidation possibilities following recommendations of the Consolidation of Services Commission.
4. Continue to monitor Citizens Review Board.
5. Monitor and support citizen access to Board of County Commissioners and the utilization of citizen input process.
6. Review current positions of the structure of Orange County Government with emphasis on the role of Constitutional Officers and members of the Board of County Commissioners.

1. Support and take action on current positions.
2. Study need for Child Services Council and impact on revenue sources for Orange County.

1. Support and take action on current position.

FAIR DISTRICTS

1. Support FairDistrictsFlorida campaign.

CIVICS

1. Expand **Teach In Day**: Provide League Members trained on citizenship and democracy for a Speakers Bureau.
