	Public Education on Governance	Develop an education program on Orange County governments and the potential impact of the Charter Review Commission
	National Popular Vote	Develop education program on the National Popular Vote Compact
	Open Primary Amendment	Work with LWVFL to gather signatures on the open primary amendment
	Counting Every Vote	Ensure that each Orange County vote is counted in the 2020 election
	Accountability of Elected officials	Assess how elected officials could be held accountable
Gun Safety	Assault Weapons Ban	Work to secure enough petitions to put Ban Assault Weapons Now (BAWN) constitutional amendment on 2020 ballot
	School Safety and Guns	Defeat state & local legislation requiring or allowing classroom teachers to carry guns on school grounds.
	Universal Background Checks	Support federal, state, and/or local legislation that removes existing loopholes for background checks on all gun sales or transfers
	Kids at Risk from Gun Violence	Support community activities and programs that promote child safety from guns and gangs
	Responsible Gun Storage	Promote "lock-it-up" campaign to reduce deaths from "accidental" shootings
